



SCHOLARSHIP SELECTION CRITERIA GUIDELINES

These are to be used by the Scholarship Selection Committee to determine the four recipients. In the event of a tie in points, past Ringette involvement will be taken into consideration.

1. # of years registered in Ringette in SK (including current Season) = 1 pt/year to maximum of 10 pts
 - Of these 10 points, a maximum of 5 can be from registration in another Saskatchewan area,
2. Academic average in the semester/year prior to the application
 - 50% + = 2 pts
 - 60% + = 4 pts
 - 70% + = 6 pts
 - 80 % + = 8 pts
 - 90 % + = 10 pts
3. Ringette Involvement in current year
 - Player = 10 pts
 - Registered bench staff on full time team = 5 pts plus pts for Certification
 - Registered bench Staff on all-star team = 3 pts plus pts for Certification
 - CSI (Level 1) = 6 pts
 - CI (Level 2) = 8 pts
 - Level 3 = 10 pts
 - Manager Certification = 5 pts
 - Trainer Certification = 5 pts
 - Official = 5 pts plus pts for Level
 - Level 2 = 4 pts
 - Level 3 = 6 pts
 - Level 4 = 8 pts
 - Referee evaluator = 5 pts
 - NCCP Course Conductor = 5 pts
 - NSIP Skill Instructor = 5 pts
 - RRA Board Member = 5 pts
 - Ringette volunteerism = 5 pts/event max of 10 pts
4. Suspended in the current year = deduct 10 pts
5. Past Ringette involvement will be taken into consideration when needed to decide between equal qualified applicants.
