Linda Ostryzniuk Memorial Scholarship for Officials

In honor of Linda Ostryzniuk, the Regina Ringette Association provides a \$500 scholarship to active officials enrolled as students in a post-secondary institution. Selection will be based on Ringette officiating involvement, community involvement and academic achievement.

To be eligible for this scholarship you must:

- o be registered with the Regina Ringette Association as a ROAR official during the full season of application
- o have been registered with the Regina Ringette Association/ROAR for at least one previous full season in addition to the current playing season
- o be attending a post-secondary institution as a full-time or part-time student (taking a minimum of 3 classes/9 credit hours).
- o **Current high-school students ARE eligible for this scholarship.** (Must be enrolled in a post-secondary institution as a full-time or part-time student)

Applicants become ineligible after reaching \$1,000 of funding under this program.

Applications must include:

- o the completed & signed application form (available on the Regina Ringette website)
- o proof of their enrolment in an approved Saskatchewan post-secondary institute
- o a transcript of marks and/or proof of standing for the last completed year/semester of education
- o two letters of reference, one of which must be from within the Ringette community
- o a photo for publication (if selected)
- o a resume with a brief outline of:
 - the benefits of their Ringette involvement
 - extra curricular activities
 - community involvement

Applications must be received by the Regina Ringette Scholarship Selection Committee by **April 30th** of the year you are applying.
