



POLICY: AFFILIATE PLAYERS (TEMPORARY PROMOTIONS) POLICY

Last Update: August 2022

1. Each team will be provided with an Affiliate Player list from their commissioner which will follow the following criteria:
 - FUN3 teams can pull-across from other FUN3 teams with advanced permission from the opposing team; This should only be done when absolutely necessary
 - U12B can draw from U10
 - U12A can draw from U12B & U10
 - U14B can draw from U12B
 - U14A can draw from U14B, U12A & U12B
 - U14AA can draw from U14A & U14B
 - U16B can draw from U14B
 - U16A can draw from U16B & U14A & U14B
 - U16AA can draw from U16A, U16B & U14AA
 - U19B can draw from U16B
 - U19A can draw from U19B or U16A & U16B*
 - U19AA can draw from U19A & U19B or U16AA*
 - 18+Open teams in all divisions must first try to pull from the Spare List roster. Only after this list is exhausted, they can pull any player in the U16 division and above (including from Open) with the following restrictions (this criterion is applicable to league play only):
 - 18+Open C cannot draw Open A, Open B, A or AA players
 - 18+Open B cannot draw Open A or AA players
 - 18+Open A - no restrictions
 - * When an U19A or AA team plays against an 18+Open team, they may use an alternate affiliate player from the 18+Open Division (A, B or C)
2. Refer to the Affiliate Player rules for maximum usage of affiliate players. All Affiliate Player rules must be followed to avoid forfeitures or suspensions.
3. To call on an affiliate player:
 - Contact the head coach of the player's team to confirm there is no conflict. It is the responsibility of the head coach to allow affiliated players to play or practice at a higher level provided there is no conflict with a game or practice. Players should be given the opportunity to play at a higher level at every chance.
 - Contact the player from the Affiliate List to confirm their interest and availability.
 - Add the Affiliate Player(s) to your score sheet roster indicating them as such with (AP) after their name.
