



POLICY: GAME SHEET AND GAME SCORE POLICY

Last Update: August 2022

1. Each team registered with the RRA will be issued game sheets for their home games.
2. The home team shall provide the game sheet prior to the game.
3. Game sheets should be printed with players listed in numerical order and must be properly completed and show team names, age group, date, time, rink, and must be signed by the team bench staff.
4. Affiliate player(s) must be indicated with an (AP) after their name on the game sheet. Goalies should be indicated with a (G) on the game sheet.
5. The scorekeeper will record the goals and penalties only as directed by the official starting at the top of the game sheet.
6. Timekeepers should post the score on the scoreboard, but never show more than a seven-goal spread.
7. Scorekeepers will enforce the Goal cap by:
 - informing the official when a player reaches the Goal Cap;
 - if a Goal is scored by a player who has exceeded their limit, the goal would not count, and the game would continue as it usually would after a goal is scored (free pass);
 - goals exceeding the goal cap limit will not be recorded on the game sheet or scoreboard;
 - goal caps will be in effect for all League, Tournament & Championship games.
8. The scorekeeper will write the final score on the score sheet before signing it. The timekeeper and shot clock operator should also sign the game sheet.
9. Both officials will check and sign the sheet.
10. In the case of a dispute, the white copy is to be kept by the winning team until the end of the season.
11. In the case of a misconduct or match penalty, the white copy will be kept by the officials and turned in to the Vice-President.
12. The winning team, or the home team in the case of a tie, is responsible to submit the game score through the TeamLinkt app within 24 hours. Children's Ringette teams are not required to submit game scores.
13. The winning team, or the home team in the case of a tie, is responsible to email a copy of the game sheet to ragamesheets@gmail.com within 24 hours. The copy can be a picture or scan, but the text must be clear and readable. FUN1/2 teams are required to submit game sheets.
14. Game scores and game sheets must be submitted within 4 hours of the completion of the game during all league playoff games.
15. Failure to complete rules, 12, 13, and 14 may result in the loss of the points in the event of a win, or the loss of the single point to each team in the event of a tie.
